## Mowbray School Long Term Music Plan KS1

### Two Year rolling programme

Pupils should;

- use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes
- play tuned and untuned instruments musically
- listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music
- Experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music.

Music builds on cross curricular themes such as phase 1 phonics, language development, sequencing, singing and signing, development of communication skills, PHSE and social skills. A range of activities are used to structure the lesson and pupils are encouraged to participate at their own level. Pupils will have the opportunity to take part in singing and listening activities in every lesson.

- improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music
- listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory
- use and understand staff and other musical notations
- appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians
- develop an understanding of the history of music.
