

## **Mowbray School Enterprise - Long Term Plan Guidelines**

**Enterprise Education is about helping young people develop enterprise capability, financial capability and economic and business understanding.**

### **Long Term Plan**

KS1 & 2 Enterprise is embedded into all areas of the curriculum and into other aspects of school life e.g. The School Farm.

### **KSS3**

In addition to Enterprising Activities, experiences and projects (e.g. Farm Studies, Horticulture, Forest School Projects, School Savings Bank) students in Key Stage 3 may also receive additional Enterprise Education/Life Skills lessons. Depending on the differentiation required for each group and the class organisation for each academic year over the KS3 students will cover a range of themes as well as develop financial capability skills appropriate to need.

"Soap Making Workshop"

"Water for Life"

"Flowerpot Challenge"

"Production Lines"

"Shops & Shopping"

"Designing & Making a product"

#### **KS4**

In addition to Enterprising Activities, experiences and projects (e.g. Farm Studies, Horticulture, Forest School Projects, School Savings Bank) some students in KS4 also get the opportunity to take part in the Enterprising activities through DT and design, make and sell the products they produce. Following completion of Mathematics coursework in Year 11 students engage in personal finance projects.
