I thought it would be useful to inform you of various things which are happening at school next week and some staffing changes.

## **Easter celebrations and activities**

We are holding our Easter service in *Bedale Methodist Church* on Burrill Road on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2017 at 10.30am. Pupils who are timetabled for outdoor education activities will not be going to the service and we will also restrict Primary swimming to just a few pupils, staff will let you know arrangements. Other specific secondary groups may also stay in school, due to the Church's seating capacity, parents are most welcome to join us. Please note the venue on the school website for this service has changed from St.Gregory's Church to Bedale Methodist Church.

Later that same day, we will be holding various Easter activities throughout the day, including;

**Easter Bonnet parade** – make them at home with your child and bring it into to school on the day. **Decorated egg competition-** the theme this year is **'Things that I am good at'**. Children can bring their eggs into school from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> April to display in the front foyer of the school. Please make sure they are hard boiled or empty. The judging will take place on Friday morning and prizes given out in our Easter assembly in the afternoon.

**Easter egg hunt** will take place in the morning for all **Primary** pupils searching for hidden eggs in the school grounds with rewards from the Easter bunny!

The annual **egg rolling and throwing** competition will take place in the afternoon, please send your child with a hard-boiled egg so they can participate in the fun!
