Easter is of course the time when we celebrate rebirth and for Christian's one of the most significant celebrations of the year. Our Easter service this morning by Reverend Kathleen has been as special as ever and all our pupils are to be congratulated for their involvement. Easter celebrations have been very exciting and a record number of decorated eggs have arrived in school. We have had egg hunts for the primary pupils; egg rolling and egg throwing competitions and the Easter bonnet parade.

This morning we have also had children & staff running the Sport Relief mile, the enthusiasm effort and spirit of everyone was very moving, this has raised £427.00, . I'm quite sure that photographs of the event will be published on the school website.

Last Friday we were presented with the President's Trophy for our Primary pupil's musical performance at The Wensleydale Festival of Music and Speech, all those who performed are to be congratulated. This is the first time we have ever won anything at this festival and the audience were moved to tears by the children's talents and performance.

The recent improvements and expansion of our facilities is reflective of our determination to provide an excellent environment for all.
